# **Call for Expression of Interest for Collaboration**

## Introduction - Background

The Euro Med Sustainability & Culture Network (EMCN) is a regional initiative launched by CulturePolis, Greece (<a href="www.culturepolis.org">www.culturepolis.org</a>), and the Lebanese Development Network (LDN), Lebanon (<a href="www.ldn-lb.org">www.ldn-lb.org</a>) in response to the growing need of enhancing collaboration between organisations in European Union countries and third countries as defined by EU, with emphasis the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) countries. It aims to build a common ground for collaboration with all interested organisations and experts in the area involved in EU projects.

EMCN future members will be public and private organisations, associations and/or institutions as well as individuals (professionals, experts, trainers, consultants and coaches) who are active in society and will enjoy a full status. We work together to build knowledge through exchanges, coordination, and synergies to implement common activities and projects. Organisations in the broader EuroMed region are invited to become members of ECMN and benefit from its initiatives.

## **EMCN Networking & Consortium Building Workshops**

One of the major EMCN activities is the setting up of a series of targeted workshops entitled: "EMCN Networking & Consortium Building Workshops", with the view to develop new ideas concerning the Euro Med region, enhance resourceful interaction and allow in return the formation of effective and solid partnerships for the various EU programmes and calls such as Erasmus+, CERV, Creative Europe, Horizon, Digital Europe, Interreg and many others, as well as other international and national funding mechanisms.

EMCN will set up international face-to-face workshops addressed to its members to discuss developments and elaborate on the formation of solid partnerships for submitting proposals for funding. All interested organisations can at any time express their interest to become EMCN members and participate in the specialised workshops.

# 1<sup>st</sup> International EMCN Networking & Consortium Building Workshop Athens, Greece, 21-22 July 2023 (new venue)

The first workshop will be open to all interested organisations and will be an exploratory one allowing to present the dynamics of the EMCN initiative, but will be limited to proposals that are related to the coming **ERASMUS+ call**, to allow for enough time for building solid consortia and effective proposals (deadline October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2023) - see <a href="https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/erasmus-programme-guide">https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/erasmus-programme-guide</a>.

Coming workshops will cover other EU programmes' calls for proposals/tenders.

#### The Call for Expression of Interest

In this context, EMCN invites organisations to submit their proposals for collaboration together with project ideas for discussion **until Sunday**, **July 2**<sup>nd</sup> **2023**.

#### Who can apply

Proposals/ideas can be submitted by organisations (meeting the criteria of the Erasmus+ programme), public or private, profit or non-profit, legally established in one of the countries of the Euro Med region such as public authorities (national, regional and/or local); foundations; non-profit organisations; and associations; universities and other educational institutions; research centres; European, national, regional and local youth organisations and platforms.

#### **Eligible countries**

Organisations can be legally sited in the EU Member States and Third countries associated with the ERASMUS+ Programme, as well as **Western Balkans** (Region 1) Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro; **Neighbourhood East** (Region 2) Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Territory of Ukraine as recognised by international law; **South-Mediterranean** Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine, Syria, Tunisia

## NB: Eligibility in specific EU programmes' calls should be checked by interested organisations

#### Focus of proposals/ideas to be submitted

The proposals/ideas should have a clear focus on collaboration with organisations in the EuroMed region and be related to one or more of the following fields of EMCN intervention, taking into account the priorities set up by the Erasmus+ programme call. More than one topic could be addressed by the proposals (indicative list).

- Culture in UN sustainable development goals (SDGs)
- Sustainable management of heritage\ UNESCO sites
- Green & Blue Culture in Society and Economy
- Cultural Sustainability in the Mediterranean

## **Proposals/Ideas Submission**

Interested organisations should submit one or more comprehensive proposals they intend to lead and/or participate in as a partner. Proposals should be submitted **in English** using the **Project Fiche**Template in Word. Proposals submitted otherwise will not be considered.

There will be a limited number of participants in the 1<sup>st</sup> Workshop in Athens.

Priority will be given to organisations having submitted proposals that they wish to lead or participate in as partners in their mature proposals

#### What to submit:

- Interested organisations are kindly asked to submit their project proposal/idea by filling in the <u>Project Fiche Template</u> and sending it to the following email address: <u>secretariat@culturepolis.org</u>, by Sunday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> 2023 (deadline extended) with the mention "EMCN 1<sup>st</sup> Workshop Proposal".
- Organisations and associated experts whose proposals will be retained for presentation in the 1<sup>st</sup> Workshop will receive an Information Pack about the venue, flights, accommodation, airports, etc., by July 4<sup>th</sup> 2023.

## Registration to the 1st Workshop

Representatives of the different organisations will have to register by **July 7**<sup>th</sup> **2023** by paying a <u>participation fee of One Hundred & Sixty Euros (160€)</u> for covering the two-day workshop expenses such as venue, coffee breaks, and lunches. Transportation and accommodation costs have to be settled by the participants themselves.
